Wild River State Park...

- consists of 6,803 acres of land, including 18 miles of frontage on the St. Croix National Scenic Riverway;
- is open all year and provides camping, hiking, skiing, snowshoeing, horse trails, nature viewing and more;
- has 94 semi-modern campsites, a primitive group camp, an equestrian campground, and several backpack and canoe campsites;
- contains hardwood forest, pine forest, meadows, oak savanna, and 450 acres of restored prairie with 1400 acres still planned;
- offers the expertise of an experienced Naturalist year 'round;
- has a scenic Picnic Shelter overlooking the river valley, complete with a deck, fireplaces and restroom facilities;
- provides a Visitor Center with fascinating displays and programs describing the history and wildlife of the area;
- has a Trail Center with wood-burning stove, fireplace, kitchen facilities and restrooms available for rental from April 15 to November 15 (in winter it is used for ski rentals);
- offers cabins and a guest house for rent within the park.
